Second essay: Attach a separate essay (**350-500 words**) about yourself, your career goals, and plans after high school using Word or Google Document.

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Complete applications and all supporting materials are due by **March 15 of every year**.

Letter of reference from one community member who is not a relative (it can also be from another teacher)

Attach essay (250-350 words) about challenges or obstacles you've overcome.

Attach an essay (350-500 words) about yourself, your career goals, and plans after high school using Word or Google Document. Applicants are restricted from using AI to write their essays. We want to hear your voice.

Essays are not graded on style or grammar but rather content.
